












We invite you to test your endurance by taking on the Yorkshire Three Peaks Challenge in aid of Springhill Hospice.

To complete the challenge you will climb the summits of Pen-y-Ghent, Whernside and Ingleborough, in the beautiful Yorkshire Dales, covering a distance of 24 miles (39km) in 12 hours. No experience or navigation skills are required. You will be part of a walking group of Springhill Hospice supporters, fully supervised from beginning to end, with expert advice from mountain leaders every step of the way, including preparation, equipment and training.

Entry is just £25 and your suggested fundraising target is £100.

To help you train for the event, you can take part in one of the training walks that are provided to help you prepare for the challenge, at no extra cost. You will also receive information about training, building up your fitness and a recommended 'kit list' that will help you achieve the goal of accomplishing the Yorkshire Three Peaks. There will be three guided groups to cater for walkers of different abilities – it's set to be a fantastic challenge!



Changing the way we provide services to keep people safe

Springhill Hospice is playing a key part in the fight against Coronavirus across the borough of Rochdale. We continue to work day and night, making sure that the most vulnerable people in our local communities continue to receive the very best, compassionate care and support.

Over the last few months, the Springhill Team has worked hard to continue the provision of essential care. Our nurses, doctors and healthcare professionals are working 24 hours a day to make sure that every patient and family receive the very best care, both on the In-Patient Unit at the Hospice and in the local community where we support patients in their own homes.


We have listened carefully to advice from the Government and are closely following their recommendations to reduce the risk of coronavirus transmission, and to protect our vulnerable patients, visitors and our staff and volunteers. As a result, we have had to make some really difficult decisions about some of our services.

We have now suspended a number of services, including those which involve public gatherings of patients, carers, family members and volunteers. This includes our Day Hospice activity, Bereavement Support Groups and Remembrance Services, in addition to the education courses and training sessions we offer.

Whilst we continue to provide the highest standard of care to patients on our In-Patient Unit, we have had to make the difficult decision to close the In-Patient Unit to visitors to help keep our patients and staff safe. We may be able to make exceptions on compassionate grounds in the last days of someone's life and our team are on hand to provide support and advice through these difficult times.

Our Community Service continues to support patients across the borough. The team is keeping in close contact with patients by telephone and video consultation. Our dedicated Hospice at Home Team are on hand to visit patients in their own homes and provide vital care when required.

Our 24 hour advice line is available to provide help and support whenever it is needed for healthcare professionals and patients and their families.



Whilst our Day Hospice is closed and our Complementary and Art Therapies suspended, we continue to maintain contact with patients on the days they would usually attend, ensuring they are supported during this time.

We've worked hard over the past few months to minimise the number of people who need to visit, or work, at the main Hospice site. As a result, many of our teams are now working from home, staying safe and helping to protect the most vulnerable people in our care. We've also said a temporary goodbye to many of our wonderful volunteers over the past few months to help keep everyone safe. We're keeping in touch with our volunteer teams and we're looking forward to seeing them again in the near future. We've also had to close our charity shops and postpone or cancel a number of our fundraising events and activities.

We understand that these measures may cause significant inconvenience for a number of our service users and supporters. Throughout this process, Springhill's main priority is the safety of our patients and other people potentially susceptible to Coronavirus. Please be assured that we are continuing to work hard throughout this period to ensure that patients still have access to necessary medical and clinical support when it is needed.

Michelle's Story

My story began in June 2017, when my Mum, Carol Anne Faust came to Springhill Hospice to have some peace and dignity in what was to be the last few days of her life.

"As a family we chose Springhill as Mum had enjoyed many a year selling her handmade cards at the fairs

there, so we knew how beautiful a place it was. We were treated

outstandingly, with care and compassion from everyone. The doctors and nurses were absolutely amazing and the attention she got was so heart-warming. I feel very privileged to have had help from Springhill. Their kindness through the most horrendous time of our lives and the opportunity to sleep on a bed next to Mum, gave me the chance to feel a closeness that nobody can ever take away from me. One nurse in particular, Hilda, went above and beyond. She offered to go and collect my Dad from Littleborough at the end of her shift, so that, as a family, we could say our goodbyes together. We could never thank her enough for that.

"Ten months later I spotted a retail job with the Hospice based at the Emporium, I had to apply - it was a sign from my Mum. Soon after, my Dad became ill with heart and kidney failure and vascular dementia. Fourteen months after losing Mum, my Dad also spent his last couple of days being cared for at Springhill. I try and support Springhill as much as I can, and I always will do. It's my way of saying thank you for the way we were looked after.

"The Sunflower Appeal is especially dear to me. The yellow sunflowers make me smile and brighten up event the greyest of days. When I'm missing Mum and Dad my sunflower plaques give me hope and comfort, and I know their love is still around me. Each year I take my Sunflower plague home, and I will always treasure them. I am very proud to say that I work for

Reception

- When did you start volunteering at the Hospice? I first became a volunteer back in 2003 so almost 17 years ago.
- What was it that inspired you to become a volunteer? I was helping out with something that was called Community Service Volunteers and the Volunteer Coordinator came to a few of us and asked to speak to whoever was in charge of the volunteering section. I asked what kind of volunteering jobs they had at the Hospice and went to have a look around to see what I'd be doing as a volunteer and after seeing what it involved I thought I'd go for it. Day Hospice

When did you start volunteering at the Hospice? I started volunteering for the Hospice in May 2018.

What inspired you to become a volunteer at the Hospice? I knew two other people who were volunteering at the Hospice and I was looking for something to do. They said why don't you apply to be a volunteer at the Hospice and after I applied I was lucky enough to start volunteering in the Day
