- 1 What possessions do you own and what is the total value of them? i.e. home or car
- 2 What is the value of your outstanding debts? Such as mortgages or loans

- 3 What is the total value of your estate? (All your possessions minus unpaid debts)
- 4 Who will you choose as your beneficiaries? Decide who you would like to leave your estate to whether it be a person or charity.
- 5 Who would you like to be responsible for any dependants? Such as children under the age of 18?
