

Day Therapies

Earlier this year we began welcoming patients back to our Day Therapies service. Day Therapies offers people respite, time to relax, to spend time with others and the opportunity to learn a new hobby or craft. Our patients are also treated to their lunch and unlimited cups of tea!

We spoke to Margaret and Wendy, two of our Day Therapies patients, who became friends after meeting at the Hospice. They told us about their experience of Day Therapies and what it means to them.

Wendy

"I come to Day Therapies every Tuesday, it really does just take your mind off everything.

"Both of us felt the same when we were asked to come to Dav Therapies, but then when you get here, and see it, you think 'wow' it's nothing like what I thought it would be.

"It's something that we need and it takes

your mind off things rather than being sat at home all day doing nothing. It's just so lovely. All the staff are just lovely and really friendly too."

"For me. I live on my own and sometimes I get depressed and Day Therapies lifts me. I like comina here. I've made some really good friends. I like just chatting and exchanging views.

"The craft sessions really help because you can lose yourself in it. You're not thinking about the worst things; you're not getting depressed or thinking

'I'm getting more ill'. I've never been a crafty person so I really like the things that I've learnt and I can take them home to do as well.

"It's just a day where you can lose yourself and relax. You don't have to do anything. You are getting taken care of and it's a safe environment."

Margaret and Wendy take part in weekly craft sessions with our Creative Therapist and other Day Therapies patients. These sessions allow our patients time to focus on a crafty project and socialise with others along with learning something new.

Unfortunately, due to Covid-19, the services that we can offer through Day Therapies are currently limited to art and craft sessions, quizzes, armchair exercises, seated bowling and discussion groups. In the future, when we are able, there wil be more therapies and activities resuming.

Louise's Story

Like many people in Rochdale I have always been aware of Springhill Hospice, but never really knew how much care they provided. All this was about to change.

My mum, Christine, was diagnosed with lung cancer in August 2017. Her prognosis was good and the plans were laid out for her treatment. But cancer had other plans for my mum and after a six month battle we were told that there was nothing more that could be done for her.

Mum didn't want to come home to die and asked if she could go to the Hospice. My wonderful friend, Claire, who is a nurse at Springhill, helped to make this happen for Mum. Claire arranged for her to be brought from Fairfield Hospital to the Hospice. As soon as Mum was brought into the Hospice the love and warmth hit us. Her face relaxed and she was happy. One thing I will never forget is one of the volunteers asking what she wanted to drink, laughing she said, "Oh I will have a Gin and Tonic!"

Two minutes later in came a G&T! She texted me that night saying she was a little tipsy! Mum received amazing care and

love in her last few days at the Hospice and nothing was too much trouble.

The staff were also amazing with my dad, my brother, me and our children. Explaining things to us all; being a support and a shoulder to cry on.

Mum died on the 15th January 2018, peacefully and respectfully in the Hospice. That night the staff let us sit with her for as long as we needed and for that I will be eternally grateful.

The ten days Mum was in the Hospice showed me what an amazing place it is. From the reception staff to the cleaners, the nurses and the volunteers. The love and care that you receive can never be put into words.

I can never say thank you enough to everyone who cared for Mum, and also my family. The one way I can show my thanks is to help raise money for them whenever I can. We buy a sunflower plaque for the Sunflower Appeal and we also support Light up a Life at Christmas.

The Makin Memories Foundation

The Makin Memories Foundation has been created by Kirsty Makin and Amy Mason. Kirsty's husband and Amy's brother, Tom, died in June 2019 aged 29. Whilst Tom was still here, together with Kirsty and Amy he wanted to create lasting memories for his and Kirsty's two daughters, Lydia and Lyla.

The Foundation is a wonderful new project, led by Kirsty and Amy, to help those with young families create long lasting memories and to help cope with the grief of losing a loved one in the same way that it helped them.

"When Tom knew that he was going to die, we wanted to try and think of things that he could leave the girls. Tom found a lovely website and they did really pretty memory boxes so we bought one for each of our girls and wrote them both a letter and put it in the box. We also had necklaces made. We got one for Tom that he wore and one for Lydia. She sometimes wears that for school if she is feeling a bit sad.

"We also made memory bears. Tom was able to leave a voice recording for both the girls in their bears. We've also had some bears made out of his clothes. We had those made for his nieces and nephews as well."

The daily pressures of their situation meant that Kirsty was looking after both her children and caring for Tom too.

Kirsty had the help of family to make sure they were able to make and



create their memory boxes, bears, jewellery and more for the girls. The help that Kirsty received from family is what inspired her and Amy to want to help others in a similar situation.

"We thought it would be a really nice idea and a way to help other younger hospice patients with children who also find themselves in this horrendous situation.

"Help those with young families create long lasting memories"

"In some cases, people don't have the kind of support network that we had. I would not have been able to think about making the memory boxes and the other things on top of looking after Tom and the girls.

"A lot of people have financial pressures too, so we thought it would be a nice way of being able to help people so they are not having to worry about it. It also means that they are able to put things in place that their children can look back on and cherish."

Kirsty and Amy are now starting to help other families who need the Hospice's services to create their own memory boxes and other mementos they can leave for their children

Kirsty and Amy will meet with families and spend time getting to know them so they can then work out what is suitable and what they feel will provide the best experience and memories for them and their children. The service is free of charge and there is a wide selection of items to help capture those special memories from hand casts to memory boxes, teddy bears and books.

The Foundation will also provide vouchers for Build-a-Bear to create a personalised bear with voice recording.

Kirsty knows first-hand how helpful and important it has been that Tom was able to leave memories and messages for his two children.

"Lydia saw Tom's ashes box and asked what was in it and it opened up the conversation. We read a book and it talked about a memory box and she asked, 'have I got one?' I told her she did. She hadn't seen it before because she was a bit too young, but she got so much comfort out of it. She read the letter that Tom wrote to her and then she asked if we could go to his wardrobe to pick some of his clothes to put in the box. So I can see the benefit that it will have for people."

Both Kirsty and Amy have been on a journey together and being able to help Springhill in Tom's memory has been important to them and, hopefully, to many families in the future.

"I think it has been a bit cathartic for Amy and I, to just feel like we're doing something positive. We never spoke to Tom explicitly about doing this, it came to us afterwards, but he always said that he wanted us to do something positive out of this. It makes us feel like there has been a small positive to have come out of it all."

Dementia Care Project

Margaret Diggle, Dementia Specialist Nurse

In 2021 Springhill Hospice applied for a grant through the Barclays 100 x 100 Community Fund, and was awarded £100,000 for our new Dementia Care Project. In April this year we were able to launch the project which will allow the

Hospice to begin providing specialist care to patients diagnosed with Dementia.

What is the Dementia Care Project?

Here at Springhill we know how complex a condition Dementia is and that those suffering with the disease deserve the same palliative and end of life support as those with other life-limiting conditions.

Although we have cared for a number of patients with Dementia, we wanted to be able to give them, and their families, more specialist care and the best support that we can.

The Dementia Care Project has allowed us to recruit a Dementia Specialist Nurse who will work across the Hospice, giving support to our clinical teams, ensuring that we can deliver the best care to patients and their families.

The funding will also allow us to provide more education and training for our clinical teams, which, together with growing staff numbers, will provide improved Dementia care across the whole Hospice.

Why is our Dementia Care Project important?

More and more people are suffering from Dementia and it is now recognised as a lifelimiting illness.

As a Hospice we pride ourselves on our excellent palliative care and end of life support for patients and their families and we want to develop and continuously improve this for all our patients.

The initial project will be funded for 2 years. At the end of the project our aim is to be in a position whereby Dementia care will be an intrinsic part of the services we offer at the Hospice.

Sheila Johnson, Director of Clinical Services said, "To be awarded this funding by the Barclays 100 x 100 Community Fund is really exciting. The recruitment of a Specialist Dementia Nurse to work across all our clinical services will make a huge difference in our ability to care for patients with Dementia and to support their families. In addition, Specialist Dementia training will enhance the knowledge and skills of our existing workforce in order for us to best care for these patients."



Lynn's Story

My wonderful dad Richard Wallwork was first diagnosed with prostate cancer in 2017. It was a huge shock to us, but Dad remained optimistic and we spent time that year making memories. Dad had always been fascinated with war memorabilia, so we set off on a trip to Belgium to visit places of interest to him. We had the best time, Dad was so happy and it's a time I will always treasure.

In April 2018 Dad began to suffer from pain in his back and shoulder and after a series of tests, it was confirmed Dad's cancer had now spread into his bones. We were informed that Dad could now only be offered palliative care. He began a course of radiotherapy and this is when we came into contact with Springhill Hospice.

Dad began receiving support and visits from Springhill's amazing Community Team. The nurses called to see him on a regular basis, were always at the end of the phone if he needed them, provided practical support and also kept in contact with me to make sure his family had support as well.

In November 2018, we began to notice a rapid deterioration in Dad. He was a very well read and intelligent man, but now all of a sudden was finding the simplest of tasks difficult and began to act very out of character.

As his condition worsened, in January 2019, Dad was admitted to hospital. They carried out tests but could not really determine anything was wrong other than his progressing cancer. After a few days they were planning to discharge him as they could not offer any further treatment. I reached out to the Community Team at Springhill as I was worried about Dad being on his own as my family and I were all working full time. Dad's community nurse arranged for him to be admitted to the In-Patient Unit at the Hospice for 2 weeks' respite and it was here that we began to witness, first-hand, the phenomenal work of Springhill Hospice. Dad immediately began to show some small signs of improvement thanks to the care and dedication of the whole team and we began to get glimpses of the Richard we knew.

Dad was keen to be back at home, so he was discharged on 31st January 2019.



Sadly, within days he deteriorated and was readmitted to the In-Patient Unit for what was to be the last time. During the following weeks, the care he received, I can never thank every member of staff and volunteers at the Hospice for enough. Dad would not eat, but one day mentioned he loved a curry, the next night at tea time; what arrived for his tea...a curry, his face absolutely lit up! A very smart man, the nurses would arrive every morning to give him a wash and shave and brush his hair. In those final weeks as he fought infections and his behaviour became more unpredictable and I have to say challenging, the nurses were so patient, so kind and just took it in their stride. Dad was so well cared for and his final weeks were spent surrounded by what I can only describe as true angels.

The support they gave to me and my family during this time I will be forever in their debt. We were allowed to be with Dad 24/7 in his final days. He was given the best care and remained pain free to the end. When Dad passed away peacefully on the morning of 24th February 2019, the team were there for us and continued to support us through those first difficult weeks.

At Dad's funeral we asked everyone to donate to Springhill Hospice as we wanted to give something back to this incredible place. We have, and will always continue, to support them in any way we can to help raise vital funds so they can keep doing their amazing work. Springhill Hospice, we can never thank you enough.
