

Volunteer Story: Sandy

After caring for her terminally ill mother, Catherine, for many years, Sandy Winkley was supported by the **Springhill Hospice at Home** team towards the end of Catherine's life.

The team provided the greatest care and compassion, allowing her Mum to experience what Sandy describes as a 'good death'; at home, with her loved ones, exactly how she wished it to be. Sandy started her volunteering journey at the Hospice shortly afterwards – although she had always known she wanted to become a Hospice Volunteer when she retired from her nursing career.

Sandy's mum, Catherine, was a Reception Volunteer at the Hospice when Springhill first opened, ensuring that Hospice life was instilled in Sandy from a young age. Sandy went on to work at the Hospice as a nurse 20 years ago and received bereavement counselling following the loss of her Mum so has first hand experience of all aspects of care the Hospice provides. "I think that some people have the wrong idea or image of what it it's like to be a volunteer at a Hospice. They might think it's depressing to be on the ward with the patients but it's not, you get so much out of it. I love supporting the patients, speaking to them and spending time with them – we have become real friends! When you're volunteering at the Hospice, you actually get more out of it than what you put in – I always feel better after a day of volunteering. The staff are so encouraging and lovely, I feel like a real part of the team."

During her time volunteering with Springhill, Sandy has covered Community, Day Therapies and Patient Companion roles – proving there **really** is an opportunity and place for everyone within the Springhill family.

"If there is anyone considering volunteering for Springhill Hospice then go ahead. You'll be welcomed and valued. It's been one of the best decisions I've made since I retired from a 45 year nursing career."

Springhill Gardens

One of the first things people notice when they arrive at Springhill is the beauty and tranquillity of our gardens. Our Gardening Team is lead by Head Gardener Michelle Hurst, supported by our amazing volunteers, who work together to ensure all the grounds are kept blooming and beautiful.

Since joining Springhill in June 2022, Michelle's key objective was to assess the existing gardens current state and use and the potential to enhance them, before making any significant changes. "Our ambitions for change focus on improving our service users' experience of the gardens. Many areas of our gardens have remained the same for years, and so their redevelopment will be evolutionary, and help to support the diverse therapeutic ways our community can enjoy the green spaces."

The first area identified as needing attention was the allotment, which was overgrown with 1m high weeds, mole-hills galore and undefined growing areas. Since autumn, the team spent many hours clearing and levelling the ground, and with the generous donation of timber and screws from David Moore of WJ Lewis, and the building skills of Ethan from Willmott Dixon, we built twenty new raised vegetable planters and enclosed our large fruit cage bed. The new allotment paths were protected with weed suppressing sheets, to avoid the need for chemical weed spraying, and covered with Christmas tree chippings kindly produced by Special Branch Tree Surgeons. These beds enable the gardening team to produce lovely organic fruit and vegetables, for the Hospice kitchen staff to create tasty and nutritional food for our patients and everyone else within the Hospice. One outstanding element remains, and that is the refurbishment of a small polytunnel – a project we hope to complete later this year once we have gathered the correct materials and expertise.

A second area, the kitchen garden outside of Day Therapies, previously consisted of a dozen raised timber beds under-utilised for growing vegetables and other foods. With the establishment of the allotment, the kitchen garden beds were made redundant, and it was decided that they should be dismantled and the materials stored for reuse elsewhere. In their place, a new wellbeing and therapeutic garden for the patients has been designed by Michelle, and approved by the Directors; the next steps are to seek grants and fundraise for the project – we cannot wait to see what the future of Springhill's grounds hold!

Steve was diagnosed with terminal prostate cancer back in 2018, which meant his care was transferred over to the team at Springhill Hospice. Steve's beloved wife Margaret visited him every day in his time on the Inpatient Unit, where he would always tell her how delicious his daily egg at breakfast was, and what joy it brought him.

One day, Steve declared to Margaret, "When I'm gone, I'd like you to pay for all the Hospice eggs for the next 5 years, I want every patient to be able to enjoy them as much as I have". Not your average type of donation, but of course Margaret agreed!

Steve passed away peacefully at home surrounded by his loving family on New Year's Eve 2018, but his time on the Inpatient Unit was not forgotten. True to her word, Margaret has paid for every egg enjoyed at the Hospice for almost four years now, and will continue to do so for as long as she can!

"I'm 82 now, but I plan to pay for the eggs for Springhill for as long as I possibly can. I'm known as The Egg Lady' by most people at the Hospice; it always makes me smile as I think of Steve – he'd be very happy that everyone is enjoying the eggs he loved so much!"

I think we can all agree that every donation we receive is immensely appreciated, and Margaret's donation is certainly very special indeed. Thank you Margaret, from everyone at Springhill – we are so happy that Steve's legacy lives on.



yorkshire Three Peaks 2023

The Yorkshire Three Peaks is a challenging full day hill walk in the Yorkshire Dales. This is a circular route, approximately 24 miles in length with an elevation gain of over 1000m. Starting and finishing in Horton-in Ribblesdale, you will climb the summits of Pen-y-Ghent (694m), Whernside (736m) and Ingleborough (723m). The challenge is to complete the walk within the allotted 12 hours, with gualified and experienced guides with you every step of the way. If you love to get outdoors, why not push yourself to do something incredible this year?

We had 50 walkers tackle the Yorkshire Three Peaks last year, which is the record to date! It raised an amazing £12,657; this amount of money could pay for one of our specialised doctors for a whole month!


